No blades will be sent back until the invoice has been paid.

Your blades will be returned in a special sturdy shipping box designed for clipper blades, inside a padded envelope or another box. You will receive tracking information when your packages are shipped. When possible, please re-use this clipper blade box when you send more blades to me for sharpening.

If you are local in the New River Valley, contact me to find out how to drop your blades off.

**** Please package your blades very carefully.** If you don't have a clipper blade shipping box, wrap each blade set separately, so metal doesn't touch metal and the teeth are well protected. Add enough packaging inside the box to prevent the blades from shifting around. Make sure there is enough packing material between and around your blades to protect them in case the box is dropped. I do not recommend using the USPS small flat rate boxes, as the cardboard is very weak and crushes easily. I do recommend obtaining adequate insurance.
